



Survivor Camp 2010 The Kid Challenge

Children will be assigned to teams and will compete in Survivor mode (all kid friendly) on a daily basis. The day-to-day schedule will consist of team and individual challenges that involve karate techniques or principles, applying the lessons learned in daily karate and self-defense lessons, ninja day, outdoor challenges, general safety training, a daily Survivor type craft, some free play time, and more.

The goal of the camp is to not only teach the children some karate and self-defense, but to teach the children to work together by planning strategies, working together towards accomplishing targeted goals, and doing whatever it takes to accomplish the goals of each challenge in the most honorable way, as a team and as an individual.
